Saints' Feast Days this Coming Week

Monday 6th February: St Paul Miki was born in Japan between 1564 and 1566. He joined the Society of Jesus and preached the gospel to the Japanese people with great success. When a persecution of the Catholics arose he was arrested together with twenty-five others. Mocked and tortured, they were eventually taken to Nagasaki on 5 February 1597, bound to crosses and speared and so were martyred together.

Friday 10th February: St Scholastica was born in Nursia, Umbria, Italy in about 480, the twin sister of St Benedict. She and her brother Benedict were brought up together until the time he left to pursue studies in Rome. They were dedicated to God from an early age and Scholastica followed her brother to Monte Cassino. Benedictine tradition holds that Scholastica established a hermitage about five miles from Monte Cassino and that this was the first convent of Benedictine nuns. She died there in about 547. She is Patron of Benedictine nuns, education and convulsive children.
