'Different ways to pray' – Lent Program The 'Different ways to pray' Lent program aims to provide parishioners with an opportunity to experience different forms of prayer. During this Season of Lent, some of the forms of prayer that will be offered within this program are: Guided Meditation, Lectio Divina, Lent reflection, the Divine Office, the Examine. These sessions will take place on a Monday morning in the Grotto Chapel in Fincairn at 10am and will roughly last about half an hour. All parishioners are welcome to attend these prayer sessions, and they aim to give the people of the parish an opportunity to experience prayer in different ways and focus our hearts on Christ on the lead up to Easter. The first prayer session will take place on Monday 27th of February at 10am and will continue on a weekly basis through the season of Lent.

Ash Wednesday Begins Lent

Derived from the Anglo-Saxon word 'lencten', meaning 'spring', Lent is a special period of reflection, fasting, and prayer. Christians are encouraged to recall the sacraments of baptism and penance in preparation for Easter Sunday, through prayer, fasting and almsgiving. Christian fasting began as a voluntary practice, as a recognition of Jesus' forty-day fast in the desert, as a support to prayer, as a way to prepare for a feast, as penance for sin, and as a way to save something for the poor — a suitable practice to prepare for the celebration of Easter. Lent invites us to make our minds and hearts ready for remembering Jesus' life, death and resurrection.
