Children's Liturgy Adult Volunteers Needed Children's Liturgy will take place every Sunday during the 10:30am Sunday Masses in St Mary's Church, Altinure. Feast Days this Week:

Monday 2nd: Guardian Angels The doctrine that every individual soul has a guardian angel has never been defined by the Church and so is not an article of faith, but is the "mind of the Church", as expressed particularly by St Jerome and St Basil and presented in both the Old and New Testaments. As Jesus says, 'See that you never despise any of these little ones, for I tell you that their angels in heaven always gaze on the face of my Father in heaven.' Thus even little children have guardian angels, and these angels remain in the presence of God even as they fulfil their mission on earth. One of the benefits of this feast is that it reminds us that God cares for us each, individually. It is easy – in times of depression or temptation – to convince ourselves that we are too small to matter, for good or ill. Today we remind ourselves that each of us has an angel of our very own looking after us; and pray to God for our own Guardian Angel.

Wednesday 4th: St Francis of Assisi preached to all, the love of God and the love of the created world; because, having renounced everything, he celebrated everything he received, saw or heard, as a gift. St Francis founded the Friars Minor, and with St Clare, the Poor Clares. He started the practice of setting up a crib in church to celebrate the Nativity and for the last two years of his life suffered the stigmata.

Saturday 7th Our Lady of the Rosary, 'Today's celebration urges all to meditate on the mysteries of Christ, following the example of the Blessed Virgin Mary who was in a special manner associated with the incarnation, passion and glorious resurrection of the Son of God.' (Divine Office)
