Feast Days this Week:

Monday 9th: St John Henry Newman was born on 21 February 1801 in London. As an Anglican clergyman for over twenty years he won renown as a preacher and theologian. A Fellow of Oriel College, Oxford, he became one of the leaders of the Oxford Movement and a prominent figure in the Church of England. On 9 October 1845 he was received into full communion with the Catholic Church by Blessed Dominic Barberi of the Passionist Congregation. After a period of study in Rome he was ordained priest on 30 May 1847. Returning to England he established the Oratory of Saint Philip Neri in Birmingham. He wrote on many subjects, most notably the development of Christian doctrine, the true understanding of conscience, faith and reason, the role of the laity. He was beatified by Pope Benedict XVI on 19 September 2010 and canonised by Pope Francis on 13 October 2019.

Tuesday 10th: St Denis and Companions. Denis came to Gaul from Rome in the middle of the third century. He arrived at what is now the lle de la Cité in Paris, where he built a church, arranged the regular celebration of Mass, and preached the Gospel. Denis and two members of his clergy, Rusticus and Eleutherius, were beheaded and thrown into the Seine in 258 and later buried at Montmartre. Their finest tribute is the abbey church of Saint-Denis where the kings of France are buried. Denis, the first Bishop of Paris, is one of the patrons of France.

Wednesday 11th: St Canice was born in Co. Derry in 527 and died in 603. Though his family were poor, he studied at Clonard under Finnian and at Glasnevin under Mobhi. A deep friendship developed between himself and Columba, with whom he worked for a long time in Scotland, where he set up several churches. In Ireland his principal foundation was in Aghaboe in Ossary. This was replaced centuries later by his church in Kilkenny.
