Feast Days this Coming Week:

Monday 11th: St Damasus, born around 304 in Spain and died on this day in 384, elected pope in 366 during calamitous. He insisted on the apostolic foundations of the Roman See, was active in opposing fourth-century heresies and promoted the cult of the martyrs. He commissioned St Jerome to prepare the Vulgate version of the Bible.

Tuesday 12th: St Finnian of Clonard (470 – 549) studied in Idrone (Co. Carlow) and later in Wales and upon his return, settled in Clonard, Co. Meath around 520, where he established a famous school. The Twelve Apostles of Ireland, amongst them Canice, Colmcille and Brenda, who were the initiators of the great monastic expansion in Ireland. He died in 549 and is remembered as the tutor of the saints of Ireland.

Thursday 14th: St John of the Cross was born in Fontiveros, in Spain, in about 1542. He spent some time as a Carmelite friar before, in 1568, Saint Teresa of Ávila persuaded him to pioneer the reform of the Carmelite order. This was a difficult task and a dangerous one: he suffered imprisonment and severe punishment at the hands of the Church authorities. He died at the monastery of Ubeda in Andalusia on 14 December 1591: the monks there had initially treated him as the worst of sinners, but by the time he died they had recognised his sanctity and his funeral

swas the occasion of a great outburst of enthusiasm. His works include two major mystical poems – he is considered one of the great poets of the Spanish language – and detailed commentaries on them and the spiritual truths they convey. He was canonized in 1726 and declared a Doctor of the Church in 1926.
